MEDIATION SERVICES, PLLC STATEMENT OF CONFIDENTIALITY

Confidentiality is an important feature of mediation. Commitment to maintain confidentiality promotes an environment in which the parties can honestly, openly and fully discuss the issues of the dispute.

All parties and mediators must hold the mediation sessions in strict confidence.

Parties who desire for any other person to be present during mediation must request approval prior to mediation.

Mediation sessions are private and confidential to the parties at the table, and also during caucus. Notes taken during mediation sessions by mediators and parties are destroyed at the end of the session.

Mediators report issues that are required by law such as child abuse or threats of physical harm to a person.

Mediators may not be called as witnesses in the event of any judicial or administrative hearing. Documents produced in the mediation cannot be used in any legal or administrative proceedings concerning the mediation.

The mediation agreement is reported to the legal that has jurisdiction.
